# HOW TO APPLY

## Applications for Full-time Courses

For Foundation and full Degree courses please complete the standard UCAS form available online through the 'Apply' system. Visit [www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com) for more details. UCAS can receive applications from **1 September 2011**. The normal closing date for applications is **15 January 2012**, but UCAS will send on late applications to the College until **30 June 2012**. After this date you are advised to contact our HE Admissions team or discuss your options with one of our careers advisers. Wiltshire College courses are very popular and fill up fast, so an early application is advised.

## Personal Statement

One of the most important sections of your application is the Personal Statement where you have the opportunity to expand on your interests and experience and tell us why you want to do the course. Mature applicants are particularly encouraged to write extensively about their history and interests.

## Applications for Part-time Courses

Please request a part-time HE Application form from the central HE Admissions team at Wiltshire College Lackham and return it to HE Admissions when complete. The team will then contact you to arrange an interview.

## Apply Early

You are strongly encouraged to make an early application and certainly by the UCAS deadline of **15 January 2012** for full-time courses. However UCAS will send on late applications to the College **until 30 June 2012**. You will be more certain of being offered a place if you apply early as our courses fill up quickly.

## Disabilities or Specific Learning Needs

The College is committed to ensuring that people with impairments, including those with learning difficulties, are treated fairly. For applicants with disabilities or specific learning needs please contact the HE Admissions team to discuss your individual needs.

## Entry Requirements

The College and partner universities set minimum entry requirements to ensure that students intending to study at the College are adequately prepared for their course. The specific course entry requirements are clearly listed in our course information sheets, available to view via our website. Wiltshire College works closely with partner universities to deliver courses which meet the needs of our students and of industry.

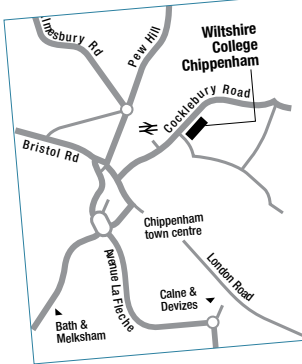
All of our courses are subject to an approval process to ensure that they're equal to the provision of other Higher Education institutions and meet the standards of our validating bodies.

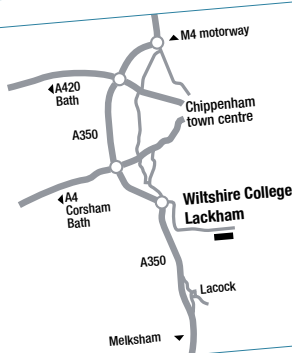

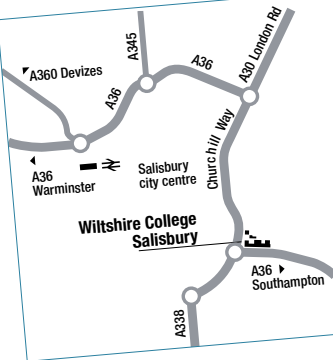

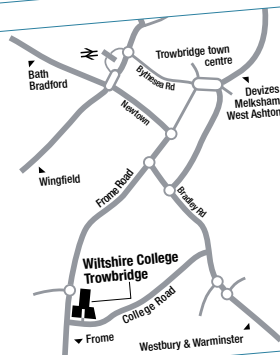
