## **Facts**

- 1 recycled tin can would save enough energy to power a television for 3 hours.
- 1 recycled glass bottle would save enough energy to power a computer for 25 minutes.
- 1 recycled plastic bottle would save enough energy to power a 60-watt light bulb for 3 hours.
- 70% less energy is required to recycle paper compared with making it from raw materials.

## **What Wiltshire College is doing....**

We provide facilities such as recycling bins for staff & students to recycle a variety of waste products within the College such as paper, cardboard, plastic bottles, cans, hazardous waste such as chemicals, light bulbs, bricks etc.

## **What you can do....**

Use the recycling facilities provided for you.

Put thought in to products that you purchase from the college as to whether it can be recycled or not.

If you believe produce materials as part of your work that could be recycled please contact your tutor.

Paper & magazines - You can recycle paper & magazines throughout the college using the little blue paper bins with the recycling sign on them, which are found in all offices and most classrooms.



Cardboard - These can be disposed of in small amounts in the mixed recycled bins (white & orange bins) located around the site. If you have large amounts of cardboard please speak to your tutor as to where to dispose of this properly.

Plastic bottles & cans - These can be recycled in the white bins with orange lids saying mixed recyclables. These can be located in the canteen, at reception, in most corridors. There is at least one bin in every building.
