

Buses serving Wiltshire College's Lackham site from

Bath, Corsham, Melksham, Devizes, Trowbridge, Westbury, Warminster & Salisbury

September – December 2016



This leaflet contains details of the network of special bus services being provided from Bath and central/southern Wiltshire, for students attending Wiltshire College's Lackham site during the 2016/17 academic year. Please check the timetables carefully as the bus routes and times may have changed this year.

These services have been designed to provide connections with a number of other bus routes to allow daily access to the college from as much of Wiltshire as possible. Indeed there are so many connections available that we do not have space in this leaflet to show them all, so if we haven't included details of buses from your home town or village, please ring Wiltshire Council's education transport hotline on 01225 713365 for details of the best route for you to use.

These services are available to all passengers and normal fares will be charged to any student unable to produce a valid Wiltshire Council bus pass. These passes are available to most full time Lackham students upon payment of an annual charge of £650 and allow the holder to make one journey to/from the college on days when the college is open. To apply for your bus pass, please pick up a form from the student services office at Lackham.

If you have any comments about these services, please contact the Wiltshire Education Transport Hotline. Please note that all of these routes may be subject to alteration during the academic year.

**All the buses shown in this leaflet will pick up and set down at any bus stop along the route.
Please signal clearly to the driver as the bus approaches (by putting your arm out)**

Please note that students wearing muddy shoes, boots or clothing will NOT be allowed to travel on these buses

If your bus is fitted with seat-belts, you must wear the belt throughout the journey - it's the law!

to all of these points, arriving back at Bowerhill at approximately 5.00pm, Devizes at 5.15 pm, West Lavington at 5.27 pm, Shrewton at 5.42 pm, Larkhill at 5.50 pm, Durrington at 5.55 pm, Bulford at 6.00 pm. Boscombe Down at 6.05 pm and Salisbury at approximately 6.20 pm.

Students must show their bus pass or pay a fare to travel on this bus.

If you cannot produce a valid bus pass you will be charged **£6 per day** (return) if travelling to/from Salisbury, Boscombe Down, Durrington Shrewton or Tilshead, **£5 per day** (return) from West Lavington, Potterne or Devizes, or **£4 per day** (return) from Bowerhill.

Concessionary bus passes cannot be used to travel on this bus.

Students must show their bus pass or pay a fare to travel on this bus.

If you cannot produce a valid bus pass you will be charged **£5 per day** (return) if travelling to/from The Ham, Trowbridge or Semington, or **£4 per day** (return) from Melksham.
Concessionary bus passes cannot be used to travel on this bus.

Connecting bus 58 operated by Frome Minibuses picks up in Frome Market Place (Crown Hotel) at 7.20 am, Chapmanslade, (opposite the Three Horseshoes) at 7.31am, and all bus stops along Dilton Marsh High St at 7.40am, arriving at Haynes Road in Westbury at 7.52am. In the afternoon, bus 58 picks up outside Barclays Bank on Westbury High Street at 5.40 pm, arriving back in Frome at 6.05 pm.

Students must show their bus pass or pay a fare to travel on this bus.

If you cannot produce a valid bus pass you will be charged **£6 per day** (return) if travelling to/from Longbridge Deverill, Sutton Veny, Warminster or Westbury, **£5 per day** (return) from Heywood or West Ashton, or **£4 per day** (return) from Melksham.
Concessionary bus passes cannot be used to travel on this bus.

If you cannot produce a valid bus pass you will be charged **£5 per day** (return) if travelling to/from Bath or Box, **£4 per day** (return) from Rudloe or Corsham, or **£3 per day** (return) from Cepen Park (Sainsburys).
Concessionary bus passes cannot be used to travel on this bus.
