

Joining Instructions

Hairdressing & Barbering

Welcome to the Hairdressing & Barbering team at Wiltshire College & University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to get ready for the start of term.

Resource Fee

You will also need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be paid via the [WCUC Online Shop](#). You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Uniform and Kit

Please also read the Kit & Uniform order instructions for information on how to order these items, this will be given to you on enrolment day. Please note that prices for kit and uniform are approximates and may vary.

We recommend that if your place is conditional on achieving exam results that you do not purchase items until your place is confirmed at your enrolment appointment.

Level 1 Hair & Beauty students require both uniform and kit.

Where uniform is not required students are required to follow a dress code of plain black, appropriate clothing. Crop tops and slogan tops are not permitted in the salon. Lecturers will discuss with you what is considered appropriate clothing for the salons at enrolment and at the start of the course.

N.B – for Level 3 Hairdressing students and Level 2 Barbering students there is the option to purchase an additional male block head for approx. £35 to support units covered in these courses. Please speak to your lecturer for further information.

Stationery

All students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include pads, pens and pencils and notes folders ready for the start of term. Course lecturers will advise of any specific requirements at the start of term.

Lockers

Personal belongings will not be permitted in the salons and will need to be stored in a locker.

Salisbury Campus: We ask that students bring their own padlocks, and a locker will be provided for you at the start of your course. Please ensure padlocks are a combination lock and not a key lock as these are often easily lost or forgotten.

Chippenham Campus: Students will be allocated a key for their lockers at the start of their course. We ask for a £5 deposit* (cash only).

Trowbridge Campus: We ask that students bring their own padlocks, and a locker will be provided for you at the start of your course. Please ensure padlocks are a combination lock and not a key lock as these are often easily lost or forgotten. In the event that there are no padlock lockers available student will be allocated a key for their lockers that will be charged at a £5 deposit* (cash only).

**Deposits are refundable when the key is returned to the department at the end of the academic year. If the key is lost, stolen or broken the £5 deposit will unfortunately not be refunded.*

Trips

All Hair students can attend trips and enrichment activities throughout the year. You will be advised of these by your course lecturers and if there is a cost this can be paid for via the [WCUC Online Shop](#).
