

Joining Instructions

T Level Health

Welcome to Wiltshire College and University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to purchase ready for the start of term. The two routes that we offer are Children's Nursing and Adult Nursing.

Resource Fee

You will also need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be paid via the [WCUC Online Shop](#). You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Stationery

Students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include note pads, pens and pencils, poly-pockets and folders ready for the start of term.

Students are welcome to use their own laptop/tablet during lessons.

Work Experience

Work experience is a **mandatory** part of your course. You are required to complete 315hrs over the 2 years.

Travel to placement will vary in cost but please be aware that you may be required to travel as far as Bath.

You will also need to pay for Hepatitis B vaccinations, if you have not already had them. Currently this costs approximately £175.

Equipment

Uniform for work experience placements consists of a tunic, black trousers and plain black footwear. Tunics must be purchased via the [WCUC Online Shop](#) at the cost of £18. You can purchase the rest of your uniform from elsewhere.

The college will pay for your Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check but you will be required to sign up for the DBS update service at a cost of £16.

Trips

Payments will be paid made individually prior to each trip (a deadline for payments will be given for these) via the [WCUC Online Shop](#).

Financial Support

We understand that we are in a financially challenging time, and the costs of attending college can put pressure on a lot of families.
