

Joining Instructions

Travel and Tourism

Welcome to Travel and Tourism at Wiltshire College and University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to get, ready for the start of term.

Resource Fee

You will also need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be paid via the [WCUC Online Shop](#). You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Stationery

All students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include pads, pens and pencils, poly-pockets and folders ready for the start of term. Course tutors will advise of any specific requirements at the start of term.

Students will need a scientific calculator if on a GCSE maths course as part of their study programme.

Equipment

All students will need to be suitably dressed for trips, visits and activities, and have any appropriate clothing, such as wet weather clothing.

We recommend that if your place is conditional on achieving exam results that you do not purchase items until your place is confirmed at your enrolment appointment.

Books

There is no mandatory requirement for learners to purchase text books for the Travel and Tourism courses, however there are various books which will help understand and support the curriculum, all which will be available through our Learning Resource Centre.

IT Equipment

We recommend that students have their own laptop or tablet which they can bring to college. All coursework assessments are completed electronically on OneNote. We only have a limited number which students can use in college only.

Trips

We have a range of trips students can attend throughout the year. These are optional.

Level 2 (example trips)

- One day trip to a purpose-built visitor attraction– approximately £40 per student
- One day trip to a heritage attraction – approximately £25 per student
- 2-3 day UK residential trip – approximately £350 per student

Level 3 Year 1 (example trips)

- One day trip to a purpose-built visitor attraction– approximately £40 per student
- One day trip to a heritage attraction – approximately £25 per student
- 3 days in either the UK or Europe – approximately £500 per student

Level 3 Year 2 (example trips)

- One day trip to a purpose-built visitor attraction– approximately £40 per student
- One day trip to a heritage attraction – approximately £25 per student
- One day trip for Cabin Crew training – no cost
- 3-4 day trip on a European city trip – £500 per student

Residential Trip Payment schedule:

- Level 2 residential cost payment dates: £150 by 25 October 2026 and £150 by 24 November 2026.
- Level 3 residential cost payment dates: £250 by 25 October 2026 and £250 by 24 November 2026.

Day Trips:

Payments will be paid made individually prior to each trip (a deadline for payments will be given for these).

Financial Support
