

Joining Instructions

Brickwork

Welcome to Brickwork at Wiltshire College & University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to get, ready for the start of term.

Resource Fee

You will need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be paid via the [WCUC Online Shop](#). You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

Stationery

All students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include pads, pens and pencils, poly-pockets and folders ready for the start of term. All students will need a 10-piece maths set to include ruler, 45% and 60% set squares, 180% protractor, compass, pencil, sharpener, eraser, black and blue pens.

Course tutors will advise of any specific requirements at the start of term.

Uniform

Steel toe capped boots/safety trainers are required and are available to purchase from several local workwear and shoe shops at an approximate cost of £30.

Sturdy work trousers/jeans to be worn with a belt approximate cost £25.

Please ensure you have these for the first day of term.

- Loose jewellery
- Shorts
- Track suit bottoms



In addition: Safety gloves and any other personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be provided, as required.

Books

Your tutor will advise of any textbooks that are recommended at the start of term. The college has a fully stocked Learning Resource Centre.
