

## Joining Instructions

### Level 2 Sport

Welcome to the Sport & Fitness department at Wiltshire College & University Centre.

Please find below details of course related costs and items you may need to purchase, ready for the start of term.

#### Resource Fee

You will also need to pay your £25 non-refundable Resource Fee before coming to enrol. This can be paid via the [WCUC Online Shop](#). You will need to bring a copy of your receipt to enrolment as proof of purchase. If you cannot pay online, please pay by card on enrolment day.

#### Stationery

Students are required to provide their own personal stationery to include note pads, pens and pencils, poly-pockets and folders ready for the start of term. Students studying GCSE Maths as part of their study programme will also need a scientific calculator.

Students are welcome to use their own laptop/tablet during lessons.

#### Course Fees

All residential trips and out of classroom activities throughout the year are **highly recommended** for students as they will be able to use evidence in their assignment work also.

You will need to pay **£250** to cover all trips, visits and uniform. Please pay this via the [WCUC Online Shop](#).

Though preferably paid in full at the at the start of term, this fee can be also paid in instalments (see instalment plan below).

Instalment plan:

- 9 September 2026: £50
- 30 September 2026: £100
- 30 October 2026: £100

## Uniform

The wearing of uniform is **compulsory** and must be accompanied by your **college lanyard**.

Your uniform will consist of:

- One T-shirt
- One ¾-zip jumper or hoody

Uniform will be issued within the first month of the course. At enrolment, students will have the opportunity to try on garments to ensure the correct sizes are ordered.

## Equipment

All students must supply their own outdoor wet weather clothing for all lessons, trips or visits as well as providing suitable footwear for any day-to-day lessons that may take place on grass pitches or astro turf, sports hall and gym.

## Mandatory Sport & Fitness Work Experience

**Work experience is a mandatory component of your course.** The required hours are as follows:

- **Level 2:** 30 hours

Students at all levels are expected to secure an **external work placement**. In addition, some work experience hours may be gained through activities involving external agencies visiting the college or through trips related to the Sports sector.

## Financial Support
